About twenty percent of the earth's surface is occupied by desert. A majority of us view deserts as area with little or no rainfall. It is common for us to see deserts as rocky or covered with gravel or pebbles and sand dunes. The lack of water has discouraged many living things living in the desert. But some plants overcome seasonal temperature changes with their extremely short and active life cycle. In event of sudden rain, the plants grow very quickly to make full use of the rain water. Their flowers bloom and set seeds that ripen quickly in the hot sun. Once the water runs dry, the mother plant dies, leaving behind the drought-resistance seeds. The cacti, a native in American desert, adapts to the dry surrounding by having unique body structures. The plant has swollen stems to help store water that carries it through months. By having sharp pines instead of leaves, water loss through respiration is minimized. Beside plants, there are also animals which can survive in deserts too.

For instance, desert lizard metabolizes stored fats in their tails, producing water to supplement their needs, just like what camel do with stored food in their humps. The desert birds need to spend a large part of their time flying in search of water holes, as they do not have special features to overcome the drought like situation in the desert.
