## **Circular: MARKSHEETS FOR THE MAM PROGRAM**

### **Preamble**

Today Gujarat Technological University is considered to be the benchmark, which most of the other technological universities are following. As the reputation of the university improves, its graduates will start commanding higher salaries, if they have used their time at GTU to transform themselves.

The reputation of GTU has become high due to the hard work of the entire GTU community. But to build something is difficult and to destroy it requires very little effort by some mischievous elements. One can defame the university, by saying that GTU is not working properly since the marksheets have not yet been issued to students of the MAM program, even when GTU has delayed it in the interest of students. Such negative reporting delays the building up of the reputation of the university to develop in Gujarat so that our graduates continue to be offered low salaries, as is the case for graduates of most of the State universities in India.

Regarding the issue of MAM marksheets, the following information has been repeatedly conveyed to all the MBA Colleges, which are offering the MAM programs. However it is being put up for the information of the GTU community.

### **The MAM Program**

The program was conceived by AICTE and many Colleges have started offering it all over the country.

However within one year of the start of the program, UGC issued a notice, which showed that the MAM degree should not be awarded by any university in India. GTU has immediately written to both UGC and AICTE and requested them to resolve the issue. Due to various reasons, it has taken some time for the two apex national institutions to resolve the issue.

Every semester GTU issues about 500,000 marksheets and GTU can issue a few thousand marksheets for MAM students also.

**For MAM students, GTU regularly declares the results every semester and all the results are available to every student at GTU's web-site.** The MAM students are still not at the Final Year and they do not require hard copies of the marksheets today. If GTU were to issue the marksheets according to the UGC order, and if afterwards UGC were to accept the name of the degree, as prescribed by AICTE, our students will fail to get the advantage of this new degree, which is likely to have a higher demand in the market.

### **Hence it is in the interest of the students to delay the issue of these marksheets.**

Let the students of MAM be assured that if it is found that even a single student is likely to suffer any disadvantage due to the non-availability of the marksheets, GTU will immediately have the marksheets printed and have them issued to all the MAM students.
