Revised Assessment Criteria for MBA Course under GTU with effect from the academic year 2015-16

As per the Academic council meet held on 19th march 2016 it is resolved to implement new passing norms in the MBA Course with effect from academic year 2015-16.

The Detail clarification for the same is as below:

- The MBA Programme is carried out based on semester pattern with four semesters in two academic years.
- The assessment pattern for MBA programme comprises a module of a final semester-end examination carried out by the University and internal evaluation by the respective colleges as well.
- All the subjects have 70 marks of GTU's final exam (E), 30 marks of mid-semester college exam (M) and 50 marks of internal assessment/Continuous Evaluation Component. (I).
- Constant analysis of assignment, seminars, quizzes, attendance, regularity and behavior takes place by the concerned faculty who decides the scheme of assessment and announces at the beginning of the term.(semester)
- The new passing norm is minimum 40 % of marks in each individual head of University exam, mid semester exam and internal assessment /Continuous Evaluation Component. (I) for all individual subjects with 50% on aggregate level including all subject components.
- The Minimum passing percentage of 40% will be fixed for each individual subject component (E, M, I, V) and 50% at aggregate level (Grand Total including all sub-components like (E, M, I, V) or if the student is not appearing in all subjects at the time (he/she has claimed / been given exemption in any of one or more subjects /Components), the passing percentage of 50% will be required for each individual subject component (E, M, I, V).

- Detail clarifications of passing marks in various course head wise are as follows:

- In case of **the backlog (less than 40% marks in any component)**; whenever student clears the component, he/she needs to get 50% marks as minimum criteria in individual subject components. In such cases, only 50% marks (max) is considered out of total marks for the subjects/head. So the passing criteria for the remedial students will be 50% in each subcomponent.
- In case of failure to clear the regular exam, the student will have to appear in the regular semester exam in the subsequent semester examination, as a remedial student.
- Any student having more than 4 backlogs after declaration of remedial exam, s/he is not allowed for further studies till he/she clears backlog/s; so as total number of backlogs are not more than 4.
- The weightage given in the syllabus is for the guidance only.
- Duration of the question paper is 3.00 hours for each of the theory subject.
- After adding the internal marks (Maximum 30) with the marks secured by the student in the University examination (Maximum 70), the marks will be converted to a letter.
- Grades are as per the following:
 1. 85 -100 marks - AA grade
 2. 75 - 84 marks - AB grade
 3. 65 - 74 marks - BB grade
 4. 55 - 64 marks - BC grade
 5. 45-54 marks - CC grade
 6. 40-44 marks - CD grade
 7. Less than 40 is FF grade
